Public holidays with no collections

New Year's Day Wednesday 1 January Collections scheduled on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday will be collected one day later and include a Saturday collection.

Good Friday Friday 18 April. Collection Saturday 19 April.



On collection day, bins should be:

- Presented before 6am on day of collection
- · One metre from road, well clear of traffic
- More than 50cm apart from one another
- Opening facing the road
- · Clear of low overhanging branches or powerlines
- Properly closed and not overfull
